China Link *From Bishop Martin*

Our World Mission Group have been considering how we extend our international contacts. We are looking at a connection with the church in China.

We are holding a gathering at the Bishop's House on the evening of Tuesday 30 April for any who would like to explore developing a connection with the Church in Chengdu in Sichuan Province in south-west China. I am interested in hearing about anyone who might like to explore this.

Last July the Revd Yuan Shiguo, Principal of the Chengdu Theological Seminary in Sichuan Province, SW China spent almost a fortnight in this Diocese exploring the possibility of a link between this Diocese and churches in that part of China. The Church in China is "post denominational" so he particularly visited areas where Churches Together is quite strong - Sudbury, Felixstowe, Ipswich and Woodbridge.
